



AF&PA Terms of Use for Statistical Publications

The American Forest & Paper Association, Inc. (AF&PA) owns the copyright to each published statistical report. Generally, members and non-members subscribers may not republish content of any AF&PA statistical report (including, but not limited to, data tables) or redistribute AF&PA publications in whole or in part, and including use in any electronic device or network, without explicit written permission from AF&PA. This prohibition includes and applies to inputting the contents of any AF&PA statistical report, in whole or in part, into open source or large language model artificial intelligence (AI) systems or applications. However, it is acceptable to reprint:

- Statistical information included in the press releases that are made available to the public by AF&PA.
- Percent changes listed in all reports for all published grades, e.g.:
 - Year over Year
 - Current Month v. Previous Month
 - Current Month v. Current Month Previous Year
 - Year to Date v. Previous Year to date
- For Printing-Writing reports only
 - (same as above)
 - Tonnage (Shipments and Inventory) as part of text (not actual tables)

Redistribution or republication of copyrighted AF&PA content beyond the information “acceptable to reprint” without explicit permission is a violation of the copyright held by AF&PA and is grounds for cancellation of non-member subscription(s) or revocation of member access to statistical publications.

Non-member subscribers must provide accurate contact information when subscribing to AF&PA reports, and must identify the organization for which they work. Misrepresentation is grounds for cancellation of your subscription without refund.
